Demarcation Point Locations for Fidium Fiber - NNE

Location of Demarcation Point

The location of the demarcation point (or points) for local exchange service with transmission speeds of DS1 and below on any property is dependent on two major factors:

1. The specific demarcation point regulation in effect for the state or jurisdiction in which the property is located; and
2. The timing of initial construction or most recent major renovation of the cabling as it relates to changes in regulation. Fidium Fiber complies with all existing state and federal demarcation point rules and regulations. These requirements do not apply to services above DS1 level (rate > 1.544 Mbps). For services above a DS1 level, Fidium Fiber's demarcation point is mutually negotiated and agreed upon between Fidium and the customer.
